On July 23rd The Preliminary Total Score for our Field Day effort is 1,824. 870 if these points were for Media publicity, Public Location, Site visit by served agency, youth participation, GOTA Station, Gota Coach and Entry submitted via web. We accumulated 954 points based on total QSOs on CW and SSB. We didn't have a digital station at the Field Day site. The points so far do not count any points that have been earned by members who checked the box for Macon County ARC affiliation on their log Submissions. 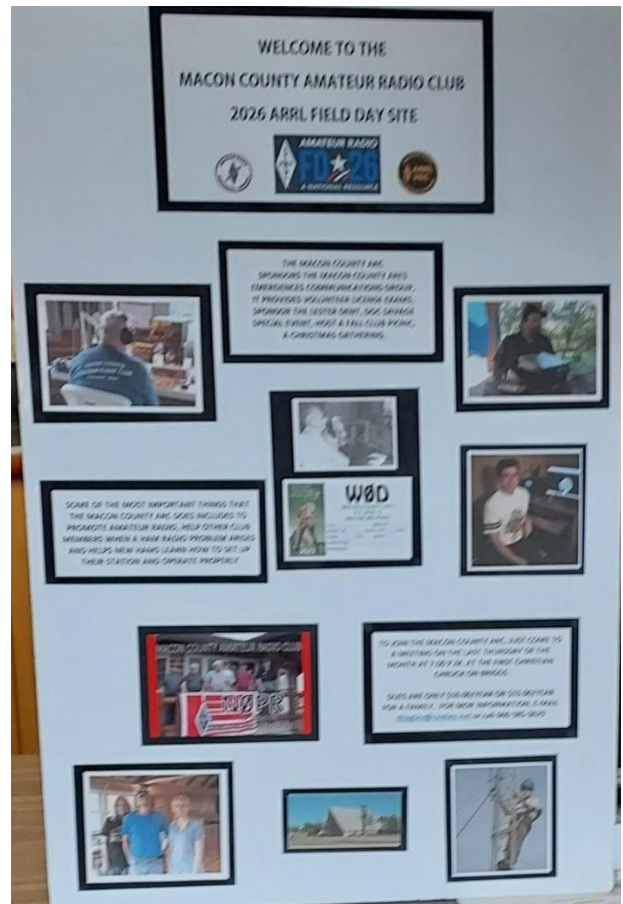
